

## Anna Davies – general bio

Anna Davies is Professor of Geography, Environment and Society at Trinity College Dublin, Ireland, where she directs the Environmental Governance Research Group and is on the steering committee for the Trinity Centre for Future Cities. She has published widely with more than 100 publications for academic, policy and public audiences and she is on the editorial boards of leading journals including *Local Environment* and *Cambridge Journal of Regions, Economies and Society*. A member of the Royal Irish Academy (RIA), she chairs Future Earth Ireland and sits on the RIA Geosciences and Geographical Sciences Committee. Nationally, Anna has advised the Irish Government as an independent member of its National Economic and Social Council and is currently a member of the Irish Climate Change Advisory Council as well as an expert advisor to the National Citizens Assembly on Climate Change. At EU level, Anna is Secretary of the European Roundtable on Sustainable Consumption and Production. At the international scale, Anna is a founding member of Future Earth's Knowledge Action Network (KAN) on Systems of Sustainable Consumption and Production, where she co-chairs the working group on social change beyond consumption. Her research interests combine environmental governance and sustainability and she currently holds a European Research Council Consolidator grant entitled SHARECITY, which is examining the practice and sustainability potential of urban ICT-mediated food sharing initiatives.
